# THE 8<sup>th</sup> SEAMS-UGM 2019 International Conference on Mathematics and Its Applications

Theme:

"Deepening Mathematical Concepts for Wider Application through Multidisciplinary Research and Industries Collaborations"

Department of Mathematics, Universitas Gadjah Mada (UGM), in cooperation with SEAMS (South East Asian Mathematical Society) organizes an International Conference on Mathematics and its Applications in Yogyakarta, Indonesia, once in every four years, as a commitment in mathematical activities to SEAMS. The first SEAMS-UGM Conference was held in 1991 and the last (seventh) conference was held in 2015.

The 8<sup>th</sup> SEAMS-UGM 2019 Conference will be conducted on July 29<sup>th</sup> - August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019. The scientific program will include keynote lectures, invited lectures, contributed presentations, and minisymposia on selected topics. The objectives of the conference are to provide a forum for researchers, lecturers, educators and students to exchange ideas, to communicate and to discuss research findings and new advances in mathematics in the wide area of mathematics. This conference is also aimed to deepen mathematical concepts and widen its application through collaboration with industries. It is also hoped that the conference will enhance collaboration between researchers from the countries in the region and those from outside the country.



# SCIENTIFIC PROGRAMME

The scientific program will consist of a conference and several workshops. The conference will consist of plenary and parallel invited lectures and parallel contributed presentations. Selected papers would be double blind reviewed and published in the AIP Proceedings (http://www.aip.org) that will be indexed by Scopus. The online proceedings will be permanently free-to-read and available to researchers worldwide without any fee to access or download the papers.

There will be several workshops as satellite event. The workshops are intended to upgrade knowledge in mathematical modelling, optimization and its computations, statistics, actuarial science, and data science.


